APPLY A BASE COAT OF AVKOTE LE

- 1. Clean the profile thoroughly with 154 Cleaner.
- 2. Apply LE onto the profile using a HVLP spray gun.
- 3. Leave this coating to dry at 20 degrees for a minimum of 1 hour.
- 4. If you are using a catalytic dryer, the drying time is 10 15 minutes.





APPLY THE STAIN

- 1. Stain can be sprayed on or applied using a sponge or mutton cloth.
- 2. If you are applying the stain by spray, you need to spray a medium coat onto the panel. If you are applying the stain by cloth/sponge, you need to wipe this over the whole surface (thin the stain as required for both applications).
- 3. Ensure all recessed parts are covered.







REMOVAL OF THE STAIN

- 1. Use a general-purpose cloth/sponge to wipe off all of the excess stain until you achieve the desired finish.
- 2. In hot weather, if the stain dries too quickly then put some water on the wipe to help remove any excess stain.





CLEAR COATING THE PROFILE

- 1. Once the excess stain has been removed and you have achieved the desired effect, leave the profile to dry overnight or for a minimum of 12 hours. You can also use heat airflow to ensure that the stain has fully cured before applying the lacquer.
- 2. The lacquer provides extra UV protection on the profile, as well as sealing the stain coating in.
- 3. Apply 1483,1485 or 1495 depending on the gloss level required. A special clear coat is available for use in catalytic dryers. Please ask AVKO Technical department for further information.
- 4. Leave to drv.
